At Holy Names Academy, the arts hold a very special place in our hearts. They are not only central to the student experience, but also a living legacy of the Sisters of the Holy Names of Jesus and Mary (SNJM). For generations, the Sisters have nurtured creativity as a pathway to the divine teaching music and visual arts, founding institutions such as the Holy Names Music Center in Spokane, and recognizing the arts as essential to a well-rounded education. When HNA was built, one of the first completed spaces was the auditorium, designed to host student performances that helped raise funds to complete the rest of the school. Among the many artistic legacies is the work of Sr. Paula Turnbull, SNIM '39, an acclaimed sculptor whose creations grace the region—including the life-size wooden sculpture of Blessed Marie Rose and a student, which warmly welcomes all who enter HNA's front doors.

Students discover joy, meaning, and self-expression as our teachers educate the whole person. Veronica Nim Olson '04, Vice President of Performance at the Bellevue Opera and an acclaimed soprano soloist,



The Arts at HNA

Art is woven into the fabric of Holy Names Academy, inspiring students to cultivate creativity and confidence. From the stage to the studio, the classroom to the chapel, artistic expression allows young women to discover their unique perspectives and share them with the world. As prolific artist, Sr. Paula Mary Turnball, SNJM '39, once wrote, "Humans cannot live without music and art. I strive to help others to fill this void."

In this issue, we celebrate the vibrancy of HNA's arts programs—Theatre & Film, Visual Art, Music, and Choir & Voice—through the lens of current student experiences and the reflections of alumnae whose lives and careers continue to be shaped by their time under the Dome. Together, these stories affirm what the SNJM Sisters knew more than a century ago: the arts are not an accessory to education, but an essential expression of it. Holy Names Academy is committed to carrying forward that vision—helping students and alumnae find connection, joy, and success through artistic expression.

Theatre & Film



Holy Names Academy's Theatre & Film Department produces a fall play, a spring musical, and the winter *New Works Festival*—where students write, direct, and perform original plays, musicals, and films. Fall and spring productions require competitive auditions, while the *New Works Festival* welcomes all who audition and concludes with an awards ceremony judged by HNA faculty, arts professionals, and HNA alumnae.

For the past 13 years, Director of Theatre & Film Sarah Whalen has guided the program with a focus on inclusivity and student leadership. "I am so proud of the welcoming, inclusive spirit that students have fostered in our program, which has led to an increase in involvement year after year," she shares. Students

lead Creative Teams—costuming, hair and makeup, visual arts, set design, and marketing—as well as lighting and sound design, and pit orchestras.

Sarah chooses works that showcase strong women making change in the world while also challenging her students. Some of her favorite past performances include *Decision Height* (about female WWII pilots who helped keep the United States running while the men were overseas), *Radium Girls* (about the women who fought against factory systems after radium exposure from painting watch dials), and *Girls in the Boat* (about the women who led the U.S. Olympic Rowing Team to record-breaking gold medals before and after Title IX.)

ALUMNAE HIGHLIGHTS

In August, Nalica Hennings '16 and Pamela Yasutake '06 brought their exceptional talents to *After Midnight* at The 5th Avenue Theatre in Seattle. Nalica, who works as a full-time performer in the Seattle area, delivered a standout performance in the production. During her time at HNA, she was a valued and accomplished student in the Theatre & Film

Department under Sarah Whalen. Sarah recalls, "Nalica had recognizable star quality even in high school. She was a bright light in every space she occupied and was instilled with an incredible sense of self, work ethic, and natural talent."

Pamela, who works as a professional choreographer and performer, choreographed *After Midnight*, which features skilled tap dancers and highlights vernacular dance of the Harlem Renaissance. Pamela reflects, "During my time at HNA, I received so much support from the faculty and my peers for my artistic pursuits. When I was a youth performer in *Black Nativity*

at the Intiman Theatre, the students taking HNA's Histories of the American People class came to the performance. Seeing my classmates and teachers in the audience was definitely a highlight of my time at HNA and my experience performing."

Visual Art



With a dynamic curriculum that blends creativity, technique, and personal expression, Holy Names Academy's Visual Art Department is flourishing. Students showcase their talents in exhibitions, contests, and collaborative projects.

In drawing and painting, young artists move from foundational skills to advanced techniques, learning shading, perspective, color theory, and composition across a range of mediums. Pottery students work handson with clay, creating functional and sculptural pieces while learning wheel-throwing, hand-building, glazing, and kiln firing. In photography, students explore digital and traditional film processes, learning to tell stories through composition, lighting, editing, and the camera's lens. For those seeking the highest level of artistic challenge, Advanced Placement Studio Art offers a rigorous, collegelevel experience in Drawing, 2-D Design, or 3-D Design. Students spend the year developing a personal portfolio that reflects a sustained investigation of a theme or concept while pushing boundaries, refining techniques, and articulating the ideas behind their art.

Amy Anderson, HNA's Fine Arts Chair and art teacher for 20 years, reflects, "It is inspiring to see students building both artistic confidence and a strong visual portfolio. My goals for the art program include supporting all learners from beginners to aspiring professionals and offering them a space to discover their voice and grow as artists. My favorite part of teaching these courses is seeing students explore their passions and talents and creating meaningful pieces of work."

ALUMNA HIGHLIGHTS

Amanda Lee '95, Assistant Professor of Painting, Drawing, and Printmaking at the University of Washington, is a multidisciplinary artist specializing in printmaking, book arts, and photography. Her images and installations evoke a sense of poetic minimalism, inspired by sacred texts, transcendentalist paintings, and manuscripts. She creates art that investigates the intersection of Indigenous knowledge systems with print media and book art theory. Amanda recalls, "At Holy Names Academy, I learned that creativity, analysis, and critical inquiry are interrelated ways of thinking. Because of the foundation I built at HNA, my creative practice is richer, more thoughtful, and more resilient."

Music



Since its founding, Holy Names Academy has made music an integral part of its program. In fact, the SNIM Chronicles the Sisters' daily record of life at HNA—highlighted music instruction as early as 1899, noting "an encouraging attendance—110 pupils, 24 boarders and 20 for music." Early graduates of the Academy would study solo and concert violin as well as piano. Today, HNA is a place where students can discover or continue their musical passions across four courses—Eclectic Strings, Jazz Band, Music Production, and Orchestra—or in private music lessons, offered to students before and after school and during lunch. For the past three years, HNA's Orchestra and Choir have begun the school year with a retreat in Bellingham. Over the course of the trip, students strengthen both their musical skills and social connections while enjoying time in nature. The retreat has become a cherished tradition and a meaningful start to the year for HNA's student musicians.

Taryn Webber, HNA's Music Director for more than 20 years, focuses on building students' foundational skills while encouraging them to step beyond their comfort zones. "My goal for the music department is to create a space where all students can find a musical home. Whether that means playing an instrument in one of our many instrumental ensembles, singing in the choir, or writing and recording music, we welcome every student and help them discover the right place to be their best musical selves!" says Taryn.



Emily Hardy '12 worked in the music industry for more than a decade. While at HNA, Emily was a part of the Orchestra, Jazz Band, and HNA Rock Band. She also took Music Production to utilize HNA's recording studio and equipment. Emily reflects, "HNA was an excellent place to explore a variety of creative outlets and learn to work collaboratively in music performance groups and on recording projects. I especially appreciated the encouragement from my teachers and college advisor (shout out to Ms. Webber & Ms. Diefenbach), who recognized my passion for music and entertainment and worked with me to find the perfect fit for college, which ended up being Loyola University New Orleans for their Music Industry program."

Choir & Voice



Whenever the HNA school community attends Mass at St. Joseph Parish or a prayer service in the HNA chapel, it is treated to the uplifting voices of HNA's Choir, accompanied by HNA's Orchestra. Hearts are stilled, and the skills of talented vocalists shine during the many performances throughout the year. HNA offers Concert Choir and Advanced Choir to all grade levels. The HNA Choir performs annually at the Archdiocesan High School Choir Festival at Benaroya Hall and at the Elliott Bay Music Educators Festival. During their senior year, students take on extra responsibilities and leadership positions.

Every year, students also audition to be a part of large honor choirs and sing with others in the state and country who are equally passionate about choral music. These students learn from this unique and rigorous experience and bring back renewed energy and enthusiasm for HNA's program.

For students ready to take on a more advanced and diverse repertoire, HNA offers Vocal Ensemble— a year-long course that meets during the school day and provides an opportunity for vocalists to refine their skills and grow as musicians. Under the direction of Dr. Jean-Marie Kent, HNA's Director of Choirs, Vocal Ensemble competed at the State competition in 2025, for the first time in 14 years. When selecting music, Jean-Marie chooses pieces that resonate with students' lives and connect to the world around them. One particularly moving piece, Song of Miriam, was prepared for Baccalaureate, capturing


both the hesitation of a first step and the confidence gained in taking it. Jean-Marie reflects, "The students in our choirs inspire me every day. Together we create artistic beauty, share deep conversations, and make friendships that last a lifetime."

Annie Stanger '15 is a middle school choir director in Snoqualmie, Washington, and sings in two Seattle-based community choirs. Reflecting on her time under the Dome, she shares, "My involvement in Choir at HNA was completely lifetransforming. In both Concert Choir and Vocal

Ensemble, I learned how to work as a successful team with my fellow singers, found confidence in my own instrument, and made some of my strongest friendships. My love for choir continued into college and now into adulthood. My life wouldn't be on this path if I hadn't started singing in choir at HNA with wonderful directors and talented peers."







DEEP ROOTS

The Class of 1965 Scholarship Endowment



Beneath every vibrant, thriving tree lies a network of deep roots—unseen, but essential to anchoring and sustaining life through every season. In the same way, scholarship endowments create strong roots of reliable support for Holy Names Academy, ensuring that the mission endures for generations.

While planning their 50th reunion, the Class of 1965 wanted to mark their years together under the Dome by preserving access to an exceptional education, celebrating lifelong friendships, and leaving a lasting legacy. The result was the establishment of the Class of 1965 Scholarship Endowment.

An endowment is an investment fund carefully stewarded by the Academy's Board of Trustees to provide annual returns. It is a perpetual gift that ensures HNA's doors remain open to every eligible young woman—regardless of her family's financial circumstances.

HNA currently has 155 named and class scholarship endowments, each providing tuition assistance to at least one student annually. Endowments are established at \$5,000 with a commitment to grow the principal amount to \$25,000 within five years. Once the investment has grown to \$25,000, the income it generates is used for tuition assistance.

The Class of 1965 has raised more than \$78,000 since 2015, including a generous \$7,000 gift in celebration of their 60-year reunion at HNA's 50th-year/50+ Reunion.

EXCEPTIONAL EDUCATION

For some, the Academy's hallmark of academic excellence remains the primary reason for giving. Merrily Hartz Hornell '65, now a retired elementary school teacher, reflects, "Pride for my education has been a part of my life since college. When I applied to Gonzaga University, the interviewer commented that he was sure of Holy Names Academy candidates."

The Class of 2025 was admitted to 243 institutions and received more than \$32 million in academic awards—proof that the Academy's tradition of excellence continues.

For Linda Jeanne De La Vergne '65, her HNA education was the foundation for her career as an insurance agent and a

life of service. "Holy Names Academy is where I learned to conduct my life with integrity, loyalty, and faith—these values filtered into my career and my roles in different Catholic parishes."

LIFELONG FRIENDSHIPS

For many, the endowment represents a depth of relationship and source of identity. This class cherishes their milestone reunions, and when COVID cancelled their 55th, Sr. Mary C. Boys, SNJM '65, started a Class of 1965 bi-weekly video call. They have not missed a call in five years!

Gerry Helt Coupe '65 shares, "When a class comes together on a project like an endowment, it unites that group of women in a new and deeper way. We communicate more and discover creative ways to generate funds, such as giving to our scholarship in memory of loved ones or in honor of birthdays, anniversaries, and Christmas. It becomes a reason to celebrate as a class. Our next goal is \$100,000. Every HNA class should start an endowment by their 20th reunion and keep it building every year, dollar by dollar."

For these alumnae, the endowment honors their formative experiences at the Academy and sustains the community that helped shape their path. They hope to inspire today's students to one day do the same.

LASTING LEGACY

At the heart of every endowment is a gift that grows and gives forever. Kathy Todd '65, lead donor for this year's fundraising campaign, inspired her classmates by saying, "Leaving a lasting legacy is an impressive accomplishment!"

For these alumnae, legacy and Holy Names Academy go back nearly a century. Sr. Mary C. Boys, SNJM '65 +\$78,000

explains, "My mother, HNA alumna 1933, very much wanted me to follow in her footsteps, but money was tight. My aunt, Kay Wegner, offered to pay my tuition. It is in gratitude for her generosity that I try to return the favor."

Their endowment is more than financial—it is an opportunity to cement their legacy and align their class with the mission of Holy Names Academy for generations to come.

"I have a deep commitment to HNA. My mother, aunts, daughters, nieces, and great nieces have attended Academy schools—it is a worthwhile place to put my money," reflects Linda Jeanne De La Vergne '65.

In a world that can feel uncertain, endowments provide something rare: reliable, lasting support that allows the Academy to live out its mission with purpose and courage. Notably, HNA endowment funds have nearly doubled over the last decade thanks to the unwavering generosity of the Academy's community.

"Our class endowment makes it possible for girls to have the same opportunity to receive the great education we did," says Karen Coury Stevens '65. Kay McWalter Tyllia '65 adds, "My husband and I want to help future families provide their daughters with an exceptional HNA education. That is why we contribute to my class endowment and include the Academy in our wills."

When asked what they hope future students will know about the women behind this endowment, members of the Class of 1965 reflected on the values behind their endowment. "Students should know that we care about the future of HNA and maintaining its traditions," notes Merrily Hartz Hornell '65. Gerry Coupe '65 emphasizes, "We did not become who we are today on our own. The women who came before us paved the way. It is our responsibility to honor and protect the history and excellence of the Academy. As the school song that we sang at assemblies goes, Holy Names Forevermore."



WHAT FIRST DREW YOUR FAMILY TO HOLY NAMES ACADEMY?

From our first campus tour, I was struck by a culture that honors tradition while embracing innovation. But that legacy is also alive in the present—it sets high expectations and offers the encouragement to reach them. foster more possibilities for Holy Names Academy's students.

I was also drawn to the school's commitment to empowerment. In an all-girls environment, students are encouraged to speak, lead, and discover without constraint. The confidence and purpose I heard in the voices of students and alumnae were qualities I hoped would take root in my own child. Leadership here isn't theoretical—it's practiced every day.

Faith and spiritual formation were essential for our family. We value reflection, gratitude, and service, and HNA's mission—rooted in Catholic tradition yet welcoming to all faiths—resonated deeply. I love that spiritual reflection and a call to service are ingrained into daily life, nurturing both intellect and heart.

possibilities beyond the classroom are endless. Whether in performing arts, athletics, STEM, or service clubs, HNA gives students countless opportunities to explore, collaborate, and grow. These experiences are as formative as any lesson learned within our walls.

WHAT INSPIRES YOUR PHILANTHROPY, AND HOW DID THAT LEAD TO THE DONATION OF YOUR MAUI TIMESHARE?

For me, philanthropy is a celebration of hope and the belief that through shared commitment and deliberate action, we can shape a better future. My path as a donor has been shaped by personal experience and a conviction that the power of education transforms lives. Donating our Maui timeshare comes from a desire to give back and to share the gift of joy and rest with someone else while supporting a cause I care deeply about. Seeing the excitement in the room and watching the Holt family win last year was exhilarating. Their joy reinforced my belief that acts of generosity, large or small, can inspire hope and make a tangible difference.

WHAT KIND OF IMPACT DO YOU HOPE YOUR SUPPORT HAS ON STUDENTS AND THE HNA COMMUNITY?

I hope whatever I offer opens doors for students who might otherwise face barriers. I want every student to feel seen, valued, and supported by a community that believes in them. Financial resources can fund scholarships, programs, or technology—but just as powerful is the message it sends: You are worth investing in.

WHAT WOULD YOU SAY TO A CURRENT PARENT WONDERING WHETHER THEIR GIFT—BIG OR SMALL—CAN MAKE A REAL DIFFERENCE?

To any HNA parent considering a contribution, I'd say: Every gift matters. The combined generosity of the HNA family creates a profound and cumulative effect. Consider the value of your contribution not only in terms of dollars but in the message it sends. It signals to your child and the broader community that you believe in the mission of HNA and the potential of its students. 


