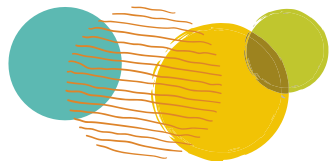

4. Each table will be notified by the auctioneer when it is time to send a runner to the dessert table to pick the table’s choice.

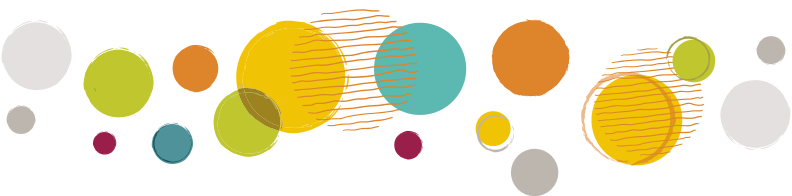
